These have been cataloged into a database and organized for use in three areas:

REFERENCE: Philatelic catalogs from throughout the world are available for review.

RESEARCH; Specialized publications can be use to search for post office cancelations, number of stamps printed, issue dates as well as the number of First Day Covers processed.

COLLECTION ANALYSIS: A staff member can assist a collector in the identification of a unique stamp, as well as helping the collector determine the missing stamps to complete a collection.

Hours: Generally the library is open Monday from 8:00 to 2:00, Tuesdays from 10:00 to 3:00, Fridays from 2:00 to 5:00. The Poway Stamp Club meets the second and fourth Wednesday of the month from 6:00 to 8:00. The library may be open on other days by volunteers, but it is always best to call first.
