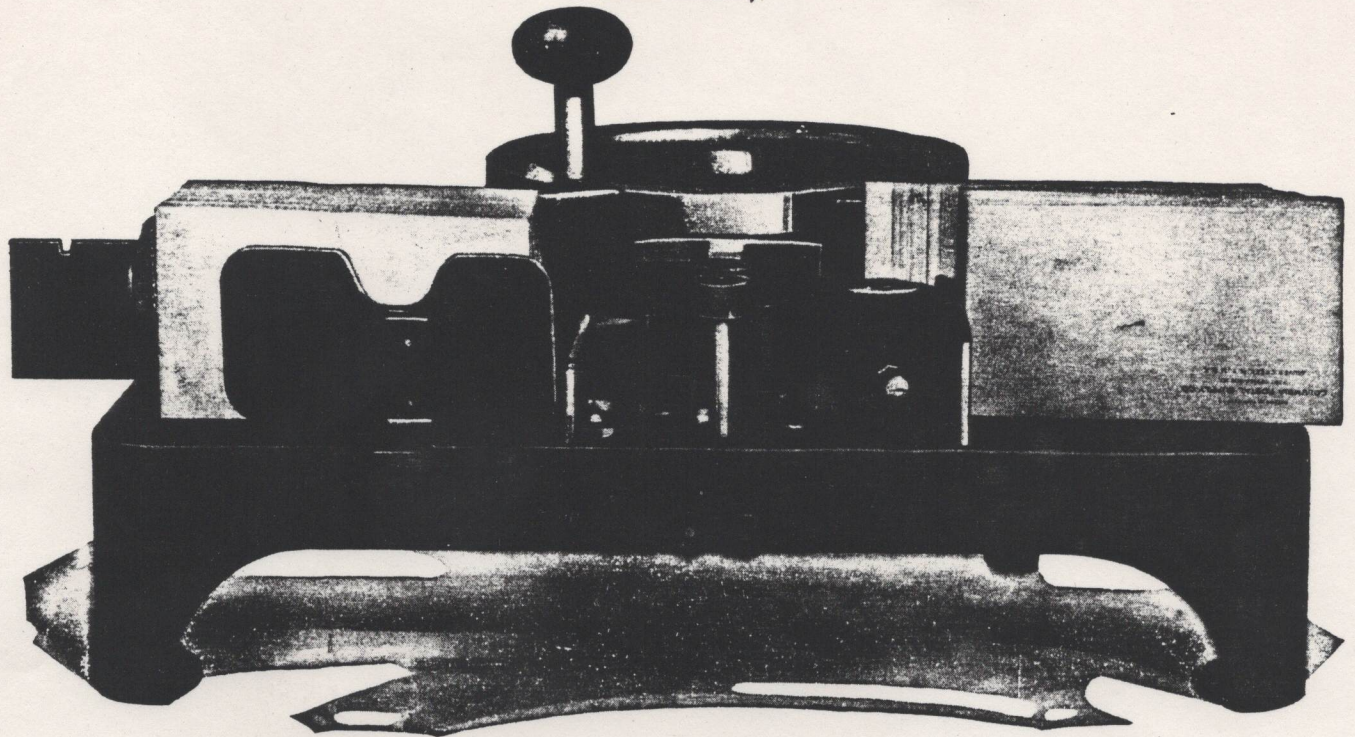


COLUMBIA JUNIOR HAND CANCELING MACHINE

Postmaster:

Our files show that you have a Columbia canceling machine in use. These Columbia machines in service today have seen anywhere from one to twenty-five years of continuous service, and a good many of them should be rebuilt for best efficiency in War time.

If your machine is a late model Junior hand machine we can rebuild it so it will look like new and be just as serviceable as a new machine for only \$15. Now is the best time of the year to have this work done, while the mails are comparatively light in volume. In the Fall months when our Christmas rush is on it is almost impossible for us to rebuild or repair machines, the demand from Postmasters taking each year every single machine we can get in shape from stock for best service.

While the War is on we are not permitted to build any new machines. This makes your machine especially valuable, and for \$15 we can put it in the same shape as machines we sell for \$99 right along.

So please give this matter your best consideration NOW, and if you are going to want your machine rebuilt any time this year let us hear from you by return mail. We are sending this circular to only a few offices at a time, so that we can return machines, thoroughly rebuilt, in 48 hours from the time we receive them.

We would like every one of our machines to go into the rush season in the Fall of 1943 in perfect condition and NOW is the time to take action to accomplish this purpose.
